### Spring Term 2024 – Year 6 Newsletter

Dear Parents/Carers

Happy New Year, and welcome back after the winter break. The children have had a great start to the term, and it is wonderful to see them excited about their new learning.

The key topics we will cover across the range of subjects are as follows:

#### **English**

During the Spring term, children will write traditional tales, narrative poetry, adventure stories and blogs. There will also be a focus on daily reading, comprehension, grammar, and spelling. Children should be reading at home for at least 30 minutes each day. Please encourage them to do this regularly, as it will help boost their fluency.

#### **Maths**

Our topics will include algebra, decimals, fractions, percentages as well as area, perimeter, volume, statistics and shape. Please support your children in practising their times tables and the inverse (x2 – x12). They will also be able to do weekly times tables homework on Times Tables Rockstars and Maths Shed.

#### **Science**

We will be studying light in Spring 1, and in Spring 2, they will be studying about animals, including humans.

#### **History**

Our topic for this term in History is Crime and Punishment in different historical periods.

#### Computing

We will continue to promote e-safety throughout the term whilst learning how to keep information safe online by using passwords. We will explore programming with an introduction to Python and in Spring 2, we will be learning about data handling.

#### **Physical Education (PE)**

We will be taking part in dance unit using visual media and putting on a performance. We will also be learning gymnastic skills, counter balancing and creating a performance with a ten-element sequence.
